COMMITTEE ON HERBAL MEDICINAL PRODUCTS (HMPC)

Meeting report, 4-5 July 2007

The Committee on Herbal Medicinal Products met for the 18th time at the EMEA on 4-5 July 2007.

Report from the Working Party on Community Monographs and Community List (MLWP)

The 9th meeting of the permanent HMPC Working Party on Community Monographs and Community List (MLWP) took place on 2-4 July 2007.

The MLWP made significant progress on the scientific work related to Community herbal Monographs and Community list entries.

The following <u>final Community herbal monographs</u> were adopted by the HMPC, further to recommendations from the MLWP:

- final 'Community herbal monograph on *Pimpinella anisum* L., fructus' (EMEA/HMPC/137423/2006)
- final 'Community herbal monograph on *Pimpinella anisum* L., aetheroleum' (EMEA/HMPC/263273/2006)
- final 'Community herbal monograph on *Foeniculum vulgare* Miller subsp. *vulgare* var. *vulgare*, fructus' (EMEA/HMPC/137428/2006)
- final 'Community herbal monograph on *Foeniculum vulgare* Miller subsp. *vulgare* var. *vulgare*, aetheroleum' (EMEA/HMPC/263292/2006)
- final 'Community herbal monograph on *Foeniculum vulgare* Miller subsp. *vulgare* var. *dulce* (Miller) Thellung., fructus' (EMEA/HMPC/263293/2006)

The Community list entries, together with their respective updated assessment reports will be transmitted to the European Commission for adoption (Comitology procedure), further to their formal adoption by the HMPC in September 2007.

Further to the discussion on the scientific assessment of *Eleutherococcus senticosus*, the HMPC adopted the draft 'Reflection paper on the adaptogenic concept' (EMEA/HMPC/99116/2007) submitted by the Working Party: The draft reflection paper intends to clarify the term 'adaptogen' which is attributed to different herbal medicinal products, among them preparations deriving from *Eleutherococcus senticosus*. The HMPC presents also in this document its position on how to approach the assessment of adaptogenic herbal medicinal products.

A meeting of the Quality Drafting Group was held on 13 June 2007.

The draft 'Guideline on quality of combination herbal medicinal products/traditional herbal medicinal products' (EMEA/HMPC/214869/2006), adopted by the HMPC at its 8 May 2007 meeting, was adopted by the joint CHMP/CVMP Quality Working Party and subsequently by the CHMP and the CVMP.

Legislation and regulatory affairs

The Committee noted the draft "Report to the Council and the European Parliament on the experience acquired as a result of the application of the provisions of Chapter 2a of Directive 2001/83/EC (introduced by Directive 2004/24/EC)" which has been released by the European Commission for public consultation until 10 August 2007.

The report was prepared by the European Commission taking into account the contribution provided by the HMPC in its status report of 31 October 2006 (EMEA/HMPC/187219/2006), in which the Committee's experience with Directive 2004/24/EC since its entry into force was presented (for background information see HMPC meeting report October 2006).

Other relevant information

In the context of the co-ordination with the CHMP, the Committee nominated Steffen Bager (HMPC member from Denmark) as the HMPC permanent observer to the EMEA/CHMP Working Group with Healthcare professionals' organisations (HCPWG).

The HMPC observer will report on and contribute to the areas where the HCPWG's future work is relevant to the Committee's remit.
