Summary of opinion<sup>1</sup> (post authorisation)

Spikevax elasomeran

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On 26 April 2023, the Committee for Medicinal Products for Human Use (CHMP) adopted a positive opinion recommending a change to the terms of the marketing authorisation for the medicinal product Spikevax. The marketing authorisation holder for this medicinal product is Moderna Biotech Spain, S.L..

The CHMP adopted an extension to an existing indication to include use of Spikevax bivalent Original/Omicron BA.4-5 as a booster in children aged 6 to 11 years. For information, the full indication for Spikevax bivalent Original/Omicron BA.4-5 will be as follows<sup>2</sup>:

Spikevax bivalent Original/Omicron BA.4-5 is indicated for active immunisation to prevent COVID-19 caused by SARS-CoV-2 in individuals **12-6** years of age and older who have previously received at least a primary vaccination course against COVID-19 (see sections 4.2 and 5.1).

The use of this vaccine should be in accordance with official recommendations.

For information, the indications for other compositions of the vaccine are provided in the summary of product characteristics (SmPC) for Spikevax.

Detailed recommendations for the use of this product will be described in the updated summary of product characteristics (SmPC), which will be published in the revised European public assessment report (EPAR), and will be available in all official European Union languages after a decision on this change to the marketing authorisation has been granted by the European Commission.
