HMPC meeting report on European Union herbal monographs, guidelines and other activities

The 96th HMPC meeting, held on 16-18 November 2020

The Chair welcomed all delegates and experts to the 96th meeting (virtual) of the Committee on Herbal Medicinal Products including Hilda Kuin as new alternate for the Netherlands.

The Committee re-elected as co-opted members Gert Laekeman as expert in Experimental/non-clinical pharmacology and Maria Helena Pinto Ferreira as expert in General and family medicine, both for another 3-year mandate starting on 24 November 2020.

The HMPC adopted the following final EU herbal monographs after public consultation:

- EU herbal monograph (combination) on Species amarae (by majority)
- EU herbal monograph (combination) on Species sedativae (by majority)

European Union herbal monograph review

Upon recommendation from the Rapporteurs, the HMPC decided after systematic review according to procedure EMA/HMPC/124695/2011 Rev. 2 that no revision is required because no new data of relevance were detected that could change the content of the:

- EU herbal monograph on Carvi aetheroleum
- EU herbal monograph on Carvi fructus
- EU herbal monograph on Caryophylii floris aetheroleum
- EU herbal monograph on Chamomillae romanae flos
- EU herbal monograph on Lavandulae flos



• EU herbal monograph on Solani dulcamarae stipites

Monographs in preparation

New assessment - finalisation

The HMPC discussed the finalisation of documents after public consultation for Aloysiae citriodorae folium for peer review and possible final adoption at the HMPC January 2021 meeting.

New assessment - drafts

The Committee agreed on draft documents for Taraxaci radix for peer review and possible release for public consultation at the HMPC January 2021 meeting.

The HMPC continued its assessment of Centellae asiaticae herba, Saccharomyces cerevisiae, Salviae miltiorrhizae radix et rhizoma, Species digestivae/ stomachicae and Vaccinii macrocarpi fructus and had a first discussion on Andrographidis paniculatae folium.

Monograph reviews

The Committee discussed the availability of new data and the need to revise monographs for Agropyri repentis rhizoma, Mate folium and Violae tricoloris herba for possible decision at the HMPC January 2021 meeting.

The members also discussed systematic reviews of Cinnamomi corticis aetheroleum, Cinnamomi cortex, Colae semen, Fumariae herba and Sabalis serrulatae fructus.

Monograph revisions - finalisation

Members discussed the finalisation of revision on Hyperici herba.

Monograph revisions - drafts

The HMPC endorsed the documents on Orthosiphonis folium for peer review and possible release for public consultation at the HMPC January 2021 meeting.

The HMPC continued discussions on the revision of Trigonellae foenugraeci semen.

Other information

Hearing with AESGP

In a hearing with the Association of the European Self-Care Industry (AESGP) the Committee received some new information and answered questions on 3 key topics in the herbal area:

Updates were given and views exchanged with regard to HMPC guidance development concerning herbal products containing pyrrolizidine alkaloids and the alignment of EU herbal monographs with Ph. Eur. monographs as regards declaration of the active substance. AESGP also presented data and views on the pharmacokinetics and metabolism of pyrrolizidine alkaloids and preliminary model predictions of relative potency.
