9.	Time limit for keeping the data	The personal data processed in this activity is stored until the individual concerned (i.e. the data subject) asks to be removed from the list. A reminder containing this information is sent to data subjects every time they receive a communication (press release, invitation, etc.).
10.	Recipients of the data	EMA's Media and Public Relations Service (press office) staff. Although the data processor (Vuelio) hosts the Agency's database of media professionals' contact details, the data processor is not allowed to access the data, and they will not use or share the data with third parties.
11.	Are there any transfers of personal data to third countries or international organisations? If so, to which ones and with which safeguards?	The data processor is located in the UK which is considered as a third country as of 1 January 2021.
12.	General description of security measures, where possible.	The Agency stores the details of media professionals in an external database.
