Background and objectives

Building [Data Quality Framework for EU medicines regulation](#) is one of the key 'Data Quality and Representativeness' deliverables set out in the [joint HMA-EMA Big Data Steering Group workplan \(2022-2025\)](#).

The European Medicines Regulatory Network has released for public consultation the first version of this framework on 10 October 2022. The document provides general considerations that can be applied to a wide range of data sources for the purpose of characterising and assessing data quality for decision making.

The main objectives of this webinar are to:

- Inform the stakeholders about the launch of a public consultation on the draft Data Quality Framework.
- Provide a walkthrough of the Data Quality Framework document and process of developing it.
