## Opinion of the HMPC on a European Union herbal monograph on *Rhodiola rosea* L., rhizoma et radix

## **Opinion**

The HMPC, in accordance with Article 16h(3) of Directive 2001/83/EC and as set out in the appended assessment report, establishes, by a majority of 23 out of 24 votes a revised European Union herbal monograph on *Rhodiola rosea* L., rhizoma et radix which is set out in Annex I.

The divergent position appended to this opinion.

This opinion is forwarded to Member States and Norway, together with its Annex I and appendix.

The revised European Union herbal monograph and assessment report will be published on the European Medicines Agency website. They replace those adopted on 27 March 2012.

## **Appendix II: Divergent position**

The member of the HMPC mentioned below did not agree with the HMPC's opinion for the following reason:

Ireland does not support the proposed Monograph for *Rhodiola rosea* L.. We have concerns regarding the potential safe use of this herbal substance "for the relief of symptoms of stress such as fatigue and exhaustion", in our view this indication is not acceptable for a traditional herbal medicinal product, in line with Directive 2004/24/EC.
