i-SPOC for MAHs: Update on registration

- As of 2 September 2022, all MAHs of products authorised in the Union were required to register an i-SPOC for supply and availability issues.
- The Agency's IRIS platform is used to collect details of i-SPOCs for all MAHs (registration opened on 28 June 2022).
- Current figures (as of 23 September 2022):
 - Total: 1385 i-SPOC registrations (~32% compliance)
 MAHs of CAPs only = 21
 MAHs of CAPs + NAPs = 107
 MAHs of NAPs only = 1257

Ongoing public health emergencies (PHEs) – reporting timelines 1/2

Monitoring supply/demand for lists of critical medicines under Regulation (EU) 2022/123

| COVID-19 | 85 | 13 Centrally Authorised Products (CAPs) + all Dexamethasone Nationally Authorised Products (~140 NAPs) | MAHs experiencing shortages (obligations started on 15 July 2022) | Once-every-month | List of critical medicines for COVID-19 public health emergency (PHE) under Regulation (EU) 2022/123 |
| Monkeypo x (MPX) | 2 | 2 | 22 August 2022 | Every-other-week | List of critical medicines for Monkeypox public health emergency (PHE) under Regulation (EU) 2022/123 |

Ongoing public health emergencies (PHEs) – reporting timelines 2/2

Guidance for MAHs:

- Currently <u>only</u> available for MAHs in scope of the lists of critical medicines
- Not published in EMA website

Template:

- Required data set (stocks, supply, demand) to be submitted <u>even</u> in the absence of shortages
- If information (e.g. supply deliveries) is not available, a <u>justification</u> needs to be provided.

Submission tool (interim*):

- SharePoint Online secure submissions (Excel files)
- i-SPOCs can delegate the reporting of required data set to other MAH users

*EMA has implemented a short-term IT solution, available from July 2022, to be used for the electronic submissions during a PHEs/MEs, until the ESMP is deployed in 2025.
